Any graduating high school senior, college freshman, sophomore, or junior is eligible to apply for a scholarship. The total number of scholarship awards is based on available funding capabilities of the NSPMA Scholarship Fund. Awards are based on the selection criteria of: *academic achievement, co-curricular participation, community service, and essay response*. Individual scholarships may range from \$500 up to \$1,500 depending on the candidate's interest, evaluation results, and recommendation from the NSPMA Scholarship Committee.

It is respectfully noted that the sponsors of this scholarship program are currently employed or retired from school personnel positions in custodial, maintenance, and/or operational services.

Award recipients will be notified in early February, and requested to reply with acceptance of this award and permission to promote and publicize on our website and social media.
