Individual scholarships may range from \$500 up to \$1,500 depending on the candidate's interest, evaluation results, and recommendation from the NSPMA Scholarship Committee.

The NSPMA Board would like to clarify to their members that their children and grand-children are also eligible for these member scholarship awards. When a member's child and /or grandchild submits a scholarship application they should indicate on the cover sheet the member's name and school district for which they are employed.

Award recipients will be notified in early February, and requested to reply with acceptance of this award and permission to promote and publicize on our website and social media.
